

Information Regarding Visits to the Internal Medicine Department

Tsukuba University Health Center **is dedicated to the health management of students and faculty members, providing care for sudden illnesses and making out short-term prescriptions.** As our medical system differs from that of general medical institutions, we ask for your understanding regarding the following points.

■ About Examinations

You may visit this center even if you have symptoms such as a fever or cough.

However, since we do not perform antigen tests for influenza or SARS-CoV-2, we cannot provide definitive diagnoses for these conditions. If, based on your symptoms or medical history, we determine that specialized treatment (such as antiviral medications) is necessary, or if you require a medical certificate, we recommend that you visit an external medical facility.

The tests conducted at our Center are as follows:

- Chest X-ray
 - Electrocardiogram (ECG)
 - Blood and Urine tests
 - Tests for paid health checkups
 - Intestinal pathogenic bacteria test
-) *There are restrictions on available tests, days, and times.

■ Prescriptions

This Center issues **short-term medication (generally for 3 days) for acute symptoms.**

If ongoing treatment is required, please visit an appropriate medical facility.

Examples of medications that cannot be prescribed at this Center:

- Steroids
- Antiviral medications (such as influenza treatments)
- Antiallergic medications other than chlorpheniramine maleate

Additionally, we do not make out prescriptions for use at external pharmacies.

■ When Specialized Medical Care Is Required:

If you require ongoing treatment, specialized tests, or specialized prescriptions, please **visit a nearby medical facility.**

We also provide information (free of charge) on medical facilities where you can receive specialized care. Please feel free to contact Tsukuba University Health Center if you would like this information.
