● **Internal Medicine** Mon.- Fri. **9:15 – 11:40 am** (up to 25 people)

Mon. Wed. Fri. **1:30 – 3 pm** (up to 15 people)

※ Chronic diseases such as asthma, diabetes, cardiovascular disease, allergy to pollen can not be examined. Influenza can not be examined or medicated, too.

● **Orthopedics** Mon. Tue. Thu. **9:15 – 11:40 am** (up to 15 people)

● **Psychiatry** Mon.- Fri. (Appointment reception) **9 am – 5 pm**

Health certificate

Students can get their health certificate from the automatic certificate issuing machine around one month after getting annual health check-up on campus. You can receive it from the University Health Center in 2 business days after applying, too. You must come in person with your student ID when applying and receiving. However, you can receive it by postage, in that case please bring a self-addressed stamped envelope (domestic postage only).

Process of examination

1. Submit your student ID or staff ID to the reception (2nd floor) and apply for the section you'd like.

If you are not sure which department to see, please consult at the reception desk.

If you wish to receive simple first aid for injury by a nurse, please ask at the reception desk.

2. **Internal medicine / Orthopedics**

Fill out an application form for each section you'd like. We require you to do it every time. In the case of internal medicine, check your body temperature with a thermometer at reception.

Psychiatry

After acceptance, we will confirm the appointment at the psychiatric reception (1F). Please get off the stairs and go to the left.

3. After the consultation, pay the fees at the 2F reception. (Pay by cash only, we don't accept credit cards.) Please wait until your name is called.

4. If you are prescribed medicine, please submit the receipt to the pharmacy.

- * Medical services at the University Health Center is charged.
- * You will not receive any medicine or examination without consultation by doctor.
- * The Health Center has only limited medical treatment and medicines. We may introduce other medical institutions so please prepare your health insurance card.
- * There are no otolaryngology, dermatology, ophthalmology, gynecology, dentistry.
- * Vaccinations other than influenza vaccine and antibody tests are not available.
- * We can't issue medical certificate or other documents concerning incident, accident or industrial accident, so please contact other medical institutions if you need it.
